This is to certify that Km/Shri/Smt. _____ whose particulars are furnished below is a bonafide person with disability “Blindness” as per definition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction (i.e. Persons having visual impairment of 90% and above)-

- I. Total absence of sight; or
- II. Visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 by Snellen’s chart in better eye with best possible corrections; or
- III. Limitation of field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree in better eye.

- (1) The certificate will be valid for (i) five years, in case of persons upto the age of 25 years, (ii) ten years, in case of persons in the age group of 26 to 35 years and (iii) in case of persons above the age of 35 years, the certificate will remain valid for whole life of the concerned persons. After expiry of the period of validity of the certificate, the person is required to obtain a fresh certificate.
- (2) The photo must be signed and stamped in such a way that doctor’s signature and stamp appears partly on the photo and partly on the certificate.
- (3) Photocopy of this certificate is accepted for the purpose of grant of concession across the counter. The original certificate will have to be produced for inspection at the time of purchase of concessional ticket and during the journey, if demanded.
- (4) No alternation in the form is permitted. **This form could be uploaded alongwith other required document on <https://divyangjanid.indianrail.gov.in/> for issuance of Divyangjan ID card, for booking of e-tickets also.** Railway Divyangjan ID card can also be prepared on the basis of UDID card/ certificate issued under instructions of Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment (MSJE). The requirement of the above Railway certificate would be dispensed in such case. In this case, the validity of the Railway Divyangjan ID would be co-terminus with the validity of that Unique Disability ID card (UDID)/ certificate.
